## Bloom's Taxonomy and the Visual Arts Communicating Ideas with Collage

**Course Description:** Art-making assignments engage students in studio practice and require knowledge of technique and process. In the course of making art, however, are your students thinking and do they understand how to orchestrate the visual language to communicate their ideas? This course will examine studio assignments through the lens of Bloom's Taxonomy and will offer an opportunity for studio practice. Participants will be guided to design curriculum that moves studio assignments from the knowledge level to the critical thinking level; and with a series of collage assignments, participants will examine the elements of art and the principles of design for the expression of an idea. Drawing expertise is not required. This course offers an opportunity to reflect on current practice and make a personal visual statement through the creation of a collage book. A \$5 studio fee will be collected by the instructor at the first class for supplies.

**About the Instructor:** **Diana Hampe** was the Visual Arts Curriculum Coordinator K-12 for the Walpole Public schools where she taught Drawing and Painting I, II, III, and Advanced Placement Studio Art: Drawing. Diana has been an AP Reader and has given AP workshops at state and national conferences. She has studied with numerous plein air painters and draws and paints the landscape in pastel, acrylic, oil and mixed media. Presently she is teaching curriculum planning in the Art Education Department at Boston University.
