Course Description: Everyone is talking about blended learning, and its power to personalize student learning. This face-to-face course is a “roll up your sleeves” workshop style course designed to introduce K-12 teachers to blended learning and support them in transitioning to a blended environment in their classrooms. Key questions to be addressed include:

- What is blended learning? What are the possible models?
- What are the 12 competencies that will make an educator effective in a blended environment?
- How do I design blended learning units/initiatives for my classroom?
- How do I establish a culture for blended learning in my classroom? How do I communicate what we are doing with parents?
- How will I set up the physical space of my classroom to support blended learning?
- What routines and procedures need to be in place for a successful blended learning transition?
- How will I know if I’ve been successful in differentiating and personalizing the learning in my classroom?

Note: This course is a companion course to the Leadership in Blended and Digital Learning program in which many TEC districts are participating.

Participants are asked to bring a laptop, tablet or smartphone to each class session.

About the Instructor: Dr. Moira Rodgers is TEC’s Director of Professional & Online Learning. She manages TEC’s part-time online course offerings that have seen an almost 400% growth in the last several years. She is a partner to districts in learning how these new learning options can be leveraged, and helping to address the needs that arise as students, parents, and staff become familiar with, and take advantage of, new ways of learning. She has been trained by the Friday Institute of Educational Innovation at NC State as a facilitator for the Leadership in Blended and Digital Learning Program. She is passionate about personalizing learning so as to inspire students. Before coming to TEC, she was the principal of Rochester Memorial School in Rochester, MA and Pre-K – Gr. 6 Director of Curriculum & Instruction for Falmouth Public Schools. She was also a 3rd, 4th, and 6th grade classroom teacher. In addition to being an adjunct instructor for Worcester State University, she has also taught for Fitchburg State University and has led many professional development workshops and initiatives across her 20+ years in public education.
