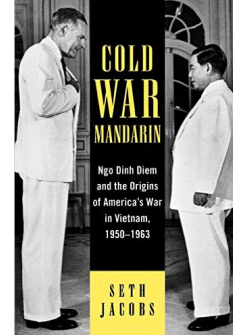

Course Description: This two-day seminar will focus on the history content surrounding the Global Cold War and the strategies to connect the content to the classroom. The first goal will be met through a series of four lectures from eminent historian Seth Jacobs. Professor Jacobs will provide the latest historical understanding of how the Cold War began, changed over time and finally ended in the early 1990s. The morning lectures will also include an exploration of the Vietnam War(s). The latter goal of the seminar will utilize the Gilder Lehrman *Teaching Literacy through History* program. How can the content provided through the historian come alive in your middle or high school classroom? Six key literacy strategies will be the focus of our afternoon sessions.

About the Instructor: **Dr. Seth Jacobs** is a political and cultural historian of the United States in the twentieth Century, especially the period since World War II, and his research interests focus on the connection between U.S. domestic culture and foreign policy. At Boston College, he teaches undergraduate and graduate courses in American military and diplomatic history, the Vietnam War, the Cold War, and America in the 1950s. He is honored to receive two Stuart L. Bernath Prizes: for best article in the field of U.S. diplomatic policy (2002) and best book (2006).
