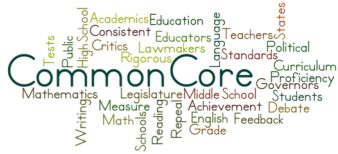


Crafting Common Core ELA Lessons with Technology

Course Description: Technology can be the cipher to engage students and provide them with the necessary skills to tackle complex texts and sophisticated writing tasks, as required in the Common Core Standards. In this course participants will:

- Create lessons that utilize technology as a tool to help students understand literature and primary sources
- Use technology to expand students' understanding of literature and primary sources
- Use the Common Core standards to align lessons with district curricula
- Integrate technology in lessons designed to deepen students' understanding of various characteristics of texts, including cultural context and historical context
- Identify a wide variety of texts that may be used in the classroom, including popular raps, YouTube videos, contemporary poetry, TED talks and written literature
- Examine various applications that support students' development of skills to read, annotate and analyze complex texts, including: Google Docs, Read, Write Think, ThingIT, Twitter, Instagram, EdCanvas, Glogster

Prerequisite: *Bring your own laptop to the class so that you will have access to the Internet for browsing and downloading. If you don't have a laptop, please let us know in advance.*

About the Instructor: **Deborah Peterson** is an experienced teacher who has also served as both a team leader and a curriculum coordinator while at Thurston Middle School in Westwood. She has used these leadership opportunities to open doors for all students. Ms. Peterson graduated from the University of New Hampshire summa cum laude, and earned a Master's Degree in Curriculum and Instruction from the University of New Hampshire School of Education.
