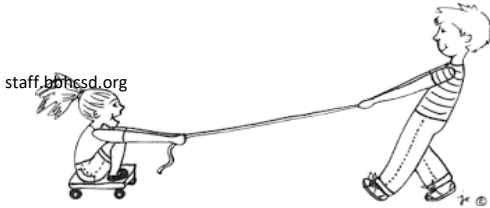


Managing Challenging Caseloads for Occupational Therapists: Putting the Fun Back into Function



Workshop Description: The student populations in school settings is ever changing and increasingly challenging. As Occupational Therapists, we are seeing increased caseload numbers to address a variety of needs among our student population, their teachers and support staff, as well as their families. This course will offer an opportunity to learn how to plan collaboratively with classroom teachers and service providers to design both inclusion and pull out

therapy sessions that directly connect to the common core standards both for academic and social emotional learning while incorporating our core goal focus for individual students. Course participants will learn ways to design sessions that address a variety of skills sets including: sensory motor development, visual perception, ocular motor function, fine motor, visual motor skills, and executive function/organization skills. Practices in consultation, data collection, report and goal writing will also be discussed.

About the Instructor: Melissa Feldman, M.Ed., OTR/L is the Occupational Therapist for Pine Hill School in Sherborn. She has worked as an OT for students with an array of special learning needs for 16 years. She also maintains a private practice, specializing in: consultation with and training for private preschools, executive function coaching and supporting families to develop and implement sensory-based strategies for the home and community.
