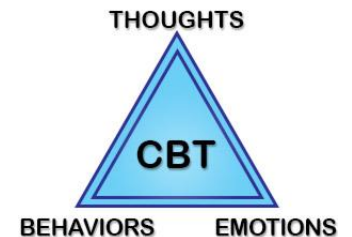


Cognitive Behavior Therapy (CBT): Tools for the PreK to Grade 4 Teachers

Course Description: Cognitive Behavior Therapy (or CBT) was initially used as a treatment for Depression. It has now expanded to support people with issues ranging from anxiety and OCD (Obsessive-Compulsive Disorder), fear of flying, dating, and social skill development. CBT focuses on developing personal coping systems to solve current problems. Once reserved for adults, CBT strategies are widely used for students in the upper elementary grades and older. We are beginning to look at ways to understand and implement these strategies in primary grades. This course will provide participants with an understanding of CBT principles, roads for application, and lots of opportunities to create grade-/issue-/student-specific tools that bring the focus on student-centered problem solving and empowerment.
